Intravenous (IV) Iodinated Contrast

- Do not eat anything for two hours prior to your computed tomography (CT) scan. You may drink clear liquids before your exam.
- You may take your regular medications with clear liquids the morning of your exam.
- If you have a history of either diabetes or renal (kidney) disease. The physician may want a creatinine blood test (which measures kidney function) performed within 30 days prior to your appointment.
- If you have a known allergy to IV iodinated contrast dye for CT and certain types of x-ray exams, it is important that you inform your physician.

Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI)

- **Please arrive 15 minutes prior to your exam.**
- If you have any metal fragments or objects such as a pacemaker in your body, or you have a fear of confined spaces, please let your doctor know when he or she is scheduling your MRI exam. Your physician may need to prescribe medicine for your claustrophobia that you will need to take as directed. For more information, please call 574.753.1452.
- **Please allow up to one hour for this visit.**

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Abdominal / Pelvic Computed Tomography (CT)

- **Please arrive 15 minutes prior to your exam.**
- **Do not eat anything for two hours prior to your CT scan.** You may drink clear liquids before your exam.
- You may take your regular medications with clear liquids the morning of your exam.
- If you have a history of either diabetes or renal (kidney) disease, your physician will want you to have a creatinine blood test (which measures kidney function) performed within 30 days prior to your appointment.
- Oral contrast material will be provided to you in the medical imaging department.
- **You will need to pick up oral preparation instructions one to two days prior to your scheduled exam.**
- IV contrast may be used depending on the exam ordered by your physician. **Please inform the medical imaging staff if you are allergic to iodine as the IV contrast material used for CT scans contains iodine.**
- **Please allow 30 minutes for this exam.**
