



# Visitor Restrictions Lifted

**EFFECTIVE APRIL 20, 2023**

## **Visitors are still encouraged to follow a few basic rules:**

- Please do not visit the hospital if you have cold or flu-like symptoms, including coughing, fever, vomiting, etc.  
***You need to stay home if you are sick.***
- If you are coming to the hospital for needed treatment while you are sick, please plan to wear a mask for the safety and protection of others.
- Please utilize the readily-available hand sanitizer stations to clean your hands before visiting, and during your time here. Frequent hand hygiene prevents infections of all types.

***Masking is optional.*** Staff members, patients, and visitors are welcome to wear a mask in any setting at any time.

Staff members will follow the standard precautions used prior to the COVID-19 pandemic when providing direct patient care. This may mean that staff will still be masked in certain situations while caring for you.

**Visitor restrictions may return at any time, with increased prevalence of COVID-19 or any type of influenza.** Thank you for your understanding and patience as we work to keep our patients safe from the spread of infection.
