

## **FUND DESCRIPTIONS**

Unrestricted Fund	Allows the Logansport Memorial Hospital Foundation to financially support programs and projects where the need is greatest.
Capital Projects Fund	Established for the purpose of funding major hospital purchases and renovations.
Cardiac Rehab Scholarship Fund	Provides financial assistance for uninsured and/or under-insured patients in need of cardiac rehab services.
Charitable Services Fund	Created to reduce the incidence of unnecessary repeat admissions. Utilized on an emergency basis to provide financial assistance in purchasing prescription drugs and/or other necessary medical products for patients in need.
Chapel Fund	Provides resources for the refurbishing and replacement of Chapel furnishings.
Diabetes Education Fund	Supports the cost of providing educational programs for diabetic patients and their families. Patients in need may also be given a scholarship to offset the cost of attending the educational programming.
<b>Education Fund</b>	Awards scholarships for Cass County students pursuing careers in healthcare. Also awards employee scholarships and financially supports health and wellness programming for local schools and/or the community at-large.
Employee Crisis Fund	Allows LMH employees to receive assistance, if they are faced with a crisis situation.
Equipment and Technology Fund	Enables the purchase of medical equipment or technology that supports patient care activities and healthcare services provided by Logansport Memorial Hospital.
Trail Maintenance Fund	Provides funding for the enhancement and maintenance of the River Bluff Trail, the Hervey Preserve, and the Huston Connector Trail.
