## **VISITOR POLICY**



All patients and visitors will be required to wear a mask, practice social distancing, and practice good hand hygiene.

Patients and visitors will self-screen at one of the designated entrances using the scanner provided.

## Visitors must be healthy—with no fever or other signs/symptoms of illness.

- Visiting hours are based on patient preference.
- Visitor restrictions may be made at the discretion of physicians/ nursing staff, based on patient needs and space limitations.
- If a patient is in isolation, please see a nurse before entering.

Emergency Room	Two healthy visitors per patient  - A maximum of two visitors in the patient's room at one time; may rotate as necessary  - Due to social distancing, our waiting space can only accommodate two visitors per patient
OB unit (Family Birth Center)	3 of the <u>same</u> healthy visitors during labor; must be at least 14 years or older  No limit on healthy visitors after delivery  Patients 18+ years old <i>may</i> have one person also 18+ stay overnight  Patients 16-17 years old <i>may only</i> have a parent or guardian stay overnight  Patients under 16 years old <u>must</u> have a parent or guardian stay overnight  For babies in the nursery, parents may visit at any time  If one parent visits, one grandparent or healthy sibling may also enter the nursery for a total of two visitors at one time; may rotate as necessary
Surgery	Two healthy visitors per patient  A maximum of one visitor in the patient's room at a time; may rotate as necessary  Pain management patients will only be allowed one visitor with them  Visitors will be informed there will be occasions when they are asked to wait in the waiting room while care is provided or procedures are performed, at any given point
Med/Surg	No limit on healthy visitors  — Any patient who is a child under the age of 18 must have an adult with them at all times
ICU	No limit on healthy visitors  - A maximum of three visitors in the patient's room at one time; may rotate as necessary  - Visitors will be informed there will be occasions when they are asked to wait in the waiting room while care is provided or procedures are performed, at any given point  - Children under 12 years of age are discouraged from visiting; exceptions can be made on an individual basis by speaking with nursing staff
Cancer Care Center	No limit on healthy visitors  – Visitors must be at least 18+ years old to be present during treatment
Therapy Services	No limit on healthy visitors  – Visitors may be asked to wait in the LMH Main Lobby because of space restrictions
Medical Imaging	One healthy visitor per patient  – Due to social distancing, our waiting space can only accommodate one visitor per patient
Laboratory	No limit on healthy visitors
Physician Offices and off-site Clinics	No limit on healthy visitors  — Any patient who is a child under the age of 18 must have an adult with them at all times
